No 21/07/2015-5L/ 77 To enable the employees working in the factories situated in District Sangrur, Barnala and Malerkotla in the State of Punjab to exercise their franchise in the Bye-Elections 2022 to Lok Sabha from 12 Sangrur Parliamentary Constituency elections to be held on 23rd June, 2022 (Thursday), it is considered in public interest to declare 23rd June, 2022 as a paid holiday in the said constituency.

Therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 65 of the Factories Act, 1948 (Central Act LXIII of 1948) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to fix Thursday, falling on 23rd June, 2022 to be a 'closed day' for the employees who are voters of District Sangrur, Barnala and Malerkotla working in Factories in the State of Punjab. However, 23rd June, 2022 (Thursday) shall not be a 'closed day' in lieu of weekly off falling between 20th June, 2022 and 26th June, 2022 on account of Bye-Elections 2022 to Lok Sabha from 12 Sangrur Parliamentary Constituency.
